# FRIENDS OF THE NC MARITIME MUSEUM IN BEAUFORT, NC How the Friends Use Donations From Corporate Partners

The Friends of the Museum is a non-profit organization supporting the NC Maritime Museum in Beaufort.

- The Museum's budget is \$1.2 million. Essentially, the State pays salaries and benefits for the Museum's staff and utilities, and approximately \$200,000.00 for services and supplies.
- The Friends annual budget of \$500,000 is an integral part of Museum Exhibits and Programs.

The Friends support projects the State is not permitted to do or cannot afford to do. Examples include:

#### Boating programs

- o Junior Sailing Program, since 1997 teaching over 200 children each summer
- o Establishing the High School Sailing Club in 2020
- Customized sailing programs for adults and teens
- o Beaufort Oars Rowing, Beaufort Women's Sailing and Traditional Skiff Clubs

- Materials for Boating and Marine Science Programs
- Insurance for boats and vehicles used by the Museum
